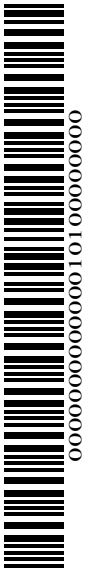

A Petition for Hearing within 30 days from the date of service or mailing of the Notice of Assessment (RCW 50.32.030)

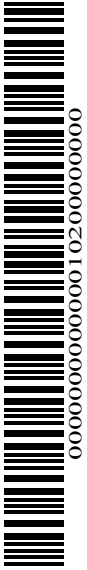

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to RCW 50.24.115, the Clerk of King County shall designate a Superior Court Cause Number for this warrant and cause to be entered in the Judgment Docket under the cause number assigned, the name of the listed employer, the date of filing of the warrant and the warrant amount of \$12,392.16 (which includes statutory filing fee of \$20.00 and satisfaction of warrant surcharge amount of \$20.00).

The aggregate amount of this warrant as docketed is a lien upon the title to and interest in all real and personal property of the employer against whom this warrant is issued, the same as a judgment in a civil case duly docketed in the office of such Clerk, and is sufficient to support the issuance of writs of garnishment in favor of the state in a manner provided by law in case of



judgment, wholly or partially unsatisfied. The satisfaction of warrant surcharge is required by RCW 40.14.027.
